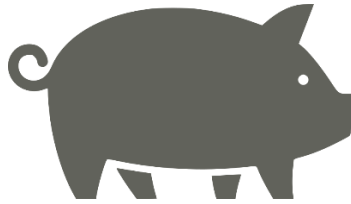


You're invited to a *Ribbon Cutting* for:
